- Attend Mass every Sunday and on Holy Days
- Attend weekday Mass at least once a week
- Spend one hour a week in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament
- Invite a friend or acquaintance to Mass
- Pray together with my family
- Discuss our Catholic Faith with my children
- Read the Bible for a half hour a week
- Spend 15 minutes a day in personal prayer
- Pray the Rosary at least once a week
- Go to confession at least every other month
- Attend a Holy Hour for Life or Vocations during the week
- Spend extra time with my spouse each day
- Listen to Catholic radio 92.5 FM

Making a consistent gift to the offertory

In thanksgiving for God's gifts, each household at Prince of Peace should give a specific percentage of income based on the biblical tithe:
